† Our Sacramental Policy †

Six-month Parish registration and participation are required for Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage.

Baptisms: Arrangements must be made in advance and parents must attend a baptism class. The Church requires that at least one of the parents be a practicing Catholic, and the Godparents must be active, practicing, fully initiated Catholics at least 16 years of age. If two Godparents: must be 1 male & 1 female; if one Godparent: may be male or female.

Marriage: Arrangements must be made at least nine months in advance. Please call the rectory office. Officiate at the ceremony must be St. Anthony Parish Pastor or a family member.

Funerals: Officiate must be St. Anthony Parish Pastor or a family member.

Please note: The services of the Parish Organist are used for all sacramental liturgies.

New Assignment

On Monday, April 23rd after the close of business, Msgr. Jeffery Day, the Vicar General and Moderator of the Curia, called on behalf of Archbishop Vigneron with a new assignment, which is to become the pastor of Immaculate Conception in Lapeer. It was a mix between an ask and a tell – something akin to Mark Faunt's term: "volun-told". In some ways I was not surprised that he was calling, however, I was hoping that I would skate by for at least another year (if not 6 like I requested).

I knew the answer was going to be "yes", but I was contemplating putting off my response for a day or two. Msgr. Day indicated that he would be making a few more calls if I said yes, which I took to mean that I was getting a replacement and that St. Anthony's was to continue on. I reluctantly said "yes", but had to wait until this weekend to make the announcement, since I was gone last Saturday.

I am not necessarily happy with the move, but I am somewhat relieved that the "shoe finally dropped". My name was being bandied about since about midway through my first term based upon what was being said at the assignment board. I am also relieved that the Archbishop chose to send Fr. Robert Slaton as my replacement. Some of you may remember him as an associate a few years ago under Fr. Rooney at Mt. Carmel.

Fr. Slaton called on my birthday to let me know that he was coming as my successor. He remembered us, but had not seen the addition of the new altar or the new rail. He was excited to see what St. Anthony's was doing based upon the website and even more excited when I told him we installed a Communion Rail for him. It also helped that we have money in the bank. There are still some glitches to work out (like the well water).

I will be replacing Fr. Doug Terrien, who has been the pastor there for years. We all thought he would be retiring from Immaculate Conception. He is replacing Fr. Rooney at Marine City. Fr. Rooney is going to a parish in Trenton.

IC-Lapeer has roughly 2000 families and a small school. There are 2 Vigil Masses on Saturday and 4 Masses on Sunday. It also has a chapel in Metamora, St. Louise, which has a Mass on Sunday. There is an associate pastor, Fr. Joseph Tuskiewicz, who has started offering the Traditional Latin Mass (Extraordinary Form of the Mass) on Thursday Morning and the Last Sunday of the Month. Looks like I am going to be very busy!

It has been a great 12 years. We celebrated my 40th and 50th birthdays and my 10th and 15th anniversary of ordination. We have seen the restoration of the parish church and the renovation of Kenna Hall. Unfortunately, we closed the school, but have seen the addition of two home school groups to the parish, one of which (St. Augustine's) is renting the school building two days a week. We have seen the implementation of the Extraordinary Form of the Mass, which has drawn a number of people throughout the region. The Knights of Columbus have streamlined their Breakfast. We have the best Rummage Sale in the area. And finally, we have added the Parish Fun Raisers.

Please continue the good work. Pray for transition of the priests that I mentioned. Pray for and support Fr. Slaton. Thanks!
