## † Our Sacramental Policy †

Six-month Parish registration and participation are required for Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage.

**Baptisms:** Arrangements must be made in advance and parents must attend a baptism class. The Church requires that at least one of the parents be a practicing Catholic, and the Godparents must be active, practicing, fully initiated Catholics at least 16 years of age. If two Godparents: must be 1 male & 1 female; if one Godparent: may be male or female.

**Marriage:** Arrangements must be made at least nine months in advance. Please call the rectory office. Officiate at the ceremony must be St. Anthony Parish Pastor or a family member.

**Funerals:** Officiate must be St. Anthony Parish Pastor or a family member.

**Please note:** The services of the Parish Organist are used for all sacramental liturgies.

## Directives for Resumption of Public Masses

I. At the discretion of the pastor, a parish in the Archdiocese of Detroit **is permitted to resume public Masses on Tuesday, May 19, 2020** under the conditions below.

II. Pride of place for attending these earliest Masses should be given to the Elect, Candidates for Full Communion, and those assisting these two groups for entrance into the Catholic Church. Directives for completion of RCIA and sacramental initiation of these groups will be forthcoming from the Office of Christian Worship.

III. All parishes in the Archdiocese of Detroit **will resume public Mass by Friday, May 29, 2020** under the same conditions.

### IV. Necessary conditions for the resumption of public Masses:

- 1. Face-coverings/masks are to be worn by the faithful in and around the church.**
- Cleaning and sanitizing of church facilities using proper techniques before or after Masses.
- 3. Physical distancing is practiced in the church and on the church property.**
- Parish churches are not to exceed 50% of total capacity for the church.
  - This limit should allow people to remain at least six feet apart.
  - Depending on church layout, this number may have to be less than 50% of the total capacity.
  - An additional location on the church property (e.g. social hall, parking lot) may be used as an “overflow” for additional people desiring to attend public Mass.
    - This should not exceed the same 25% capacity for the space.
    - Both indoor and outdoor Masses require adherence to strict physical distancing guidelines.

V. Funerals, Weddings, and Baptisms no longer require individual permission and may resume along the same timeline and under the same conditions.

VI. All non-liturgical gatherings should continue to be suspended. At the pastor’s discretion, exceptions may be made if attendees observe strict health and safety guidelines and the gathering does not exceed 10 persons at any one time.

VII. All the faithful in the Archdiocese of Detroit are dispensed from their Sunday obligation to attend Mass through Sunday, September 6, 2020.
