
The parish offices will be <u>closed from</u> <u>December 24-January 1.</u> The offices will re-open on Thursday, January 2, at 9:00am.

Our Sacramental Policy †

Six-month Parish registration and participation are required for Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage.

Baptisms: Arrangements must be made in advance and parents must attend a baptism class. The Church requires that at least one of the parents be a practicing Catholic, and the Godparents must be active, practicing, fully initiated Catholics at least 16 years of age. If two Godparents: must be 1 male & 1 female; if one Godparent: may be male or female.

Marriage: Arrangements must be made at least nine months in advance. Please call the Parish Officiate at the ceremony must be St. Anthony Parish Pastor or a family member.

Funerals: Officiate must be St. Anthony Parish Pastor or a family member.

Please note: The services of the Parish Organist are used for all sacramental liturgies.



A Reminder regarding Christmas **Donations**

Any Christmas contributions made to St. Anthony Parish are not subject to the Archdiocesan assessment; in other words, the entire amount stays in the Parish funds. The contributions must be received no earlier than 2 weeks prior, and no later than 2 weeks after Christmas.

This is the last weekend that the Knights of Columbus will be offering Christmas cards for purchase after each of the weekend Masses! It is a limited supply (54 boxes, 40 envelope seals, and 10 lapel pins). The next dates are Sat. Dec. 21 after 6:00pm Mass, and Sun. Dec. 22 after both Sunday Masses.


